JOB TITLE: Mayflower Advisor

LENGTH OF WORK:

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- I. The advisor of the Mayflower teaches students all journalism techniques needed to create a yearbook: copy writing, copy editing, layout, design and photography. When these skills are mastered the students begin to produce the yearbook under the guidance of the yearbook advisor. The advisor chooses an editor and most of the responsibility for directing the staff should then come from this editor. This position teaches the editor a tremendous amount of leadership skills and responsibility.

- II. Although the advisor is responsible for seeing that all the facets of the yearbook (planning, teaching, designing and producing) are carried through, the advisor must not actually work on the yearbook. It should be the result of the students' labor and creativity. A final responsibility of the yearbook advisor is to maintain good attitudes and compatibility between the yearbook staff. Without positive working conditions and a general feeling of good will and unity, the yearbook would not be a quality product that would typify the pride students take in their yearbook.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE:

Certified teacher and employment with the Plymouth Community School Corporation if required by the IHSAA; or related experience and/or training.

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of athletes, school officials, parents, and the press.

MATHEMATICAL SKILL:

Ability to work with mathematical concepts. Ability to apply concepts such as fractions, percentages, ratios, and proportions to practical situations.

REASONING ABILITY:

Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand, walk, sit, use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls, reach with hands and arms, and taste or smell.

The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 10 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

The employee should be able to use the machines, tools, equipment, and work aids which may be representative of those commonly associated with this type of work.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

The working environment is mainly indoors other than routine errands.

There are no environmental hazards indicated for this position.
